

BATTING CAGE RULES

- 1. Use of the batting cages is on a <u>first-come</u>, <u>first serve basis</u>. If people are waiting to use the batting cages, use is <u>limited to 30 minutes</u>.
- 2. DURING SCHEDULED GAMES, THE BATTING CAGE IS RESERVED FOR PLAYING TEAMS ONLY.
- 3. ALL USERS OF THE BATTING CAGES UNDERSTAND THEY **USE THE FACILITY AT THEIR OWN RISK**. THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS IS
 NOT LIABLE FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR EQUIPMENT DAMAGE
 SUSTAINED IN OR AROUND THE BATTING CAGES.
- 4. ABSOLUTELY **NO METAL CLEATS** ARE ALLOWED IN THE BATTING CAGES. BATTERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR RUBBER CLEATS OR CLOSED-TOED SHOES WHILE IN THE BATTING CAGE.
- 5. ALL BATTERS **MUST** WEAR A HELMET.
- 6. Youth under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 7. ONLY TWO (2) PEOPLE WILL BE IN THE CAGE AT ONE TIME: THE BATTER AND PITCHER/PITCHING MACHINE OPERATOR.
- 8. ALL PITCHERS/PITCHING MACHINE OPERATORS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO USE "L-SCREEN" PROTECTIVE SCREENS AT ALL TIMES OF OPERATION.
- 9. WHEN A PITCHING MACHINE IS USED INSIDE THE BATTING CAGE, THE PITCHING MACHINE OPERATOR MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE.
- 10. WHEN THE CAGE IS IN USE, THE CHAIN-LINK ACCESS GATE MUST BE CLOSED TO PREVENT OUTSIDE OBSERVERS FROM BEING EXPOSED TO HIT BALLS.
- 11. NO PRIVATE LESSONS OR PERSONAL TRAINING.
- No T-Ball or Soft Toss HITTING OUTSIDE OF THE BATTING CAGE.
- 13. No food or drink is allowed inside the batting cage.
- 14. NO PETS ALLOWED INSIDE THE BATTING CAGE.
