

BATTING CAGE RULES

- 1. USE OF THE BATTING CAGES IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS. IF PEOPLE ARE WAITING TO USE THE BATTING CAGES, USE IS LIMITED TO 30 MINUTES.**
- 2. DURING SCHEDULED GAMES, THE BATTING CAGE IS RESERVED FOR PLAYING TEAMS ONLY.**
- 3. ALL USERS OF THE BATTING CAGES UNDERSTAND THEY USE THE FACILITY AT THEIR OWN RISK. THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS IS NOT LIABLE FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR EQUIPMENT DAMAGE SUSTAINED IN OR AROUND THE BATTING CAGES.**
- 4. ABSOLUTELY NO METAL CLEATS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BATTING CAGES. BATTERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR RUBBER CLEATS OR CLOSED-TOED SHOES WHILE IN THE BATTING CAGE.**
- 5. ALL BATTERS **MUST** WEAR A HELMET.**
- 6. YOUTH UNDER THE AGE OF 13 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.**
- 7. ONLY TWO (2) PEOPLE WILL BE IN THE CAGE AT ONE TIME: THE BATTER AND PITCHER/PITCHING MACHINE OPERATOR.**
- 8. ALL PITCHERS/PITCHING MACHINE OPERATORS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO USE “L-SCREEN” PROTECTIVE SCREENS AT ALL TIMES OF OPERATION.**
- 9. WHEN A PITCHING MACHINE IS USED INSIDE THE BATTING CAGE, THE PITCHING MACHINE OPERATOR MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE.**
- 10. WHEN THE CAGE IS IN USE, THE CHAIN-LINK ACCESS GATE MUST BE CLOSED TO PREVENT OUTSIDE OBSERVERS FROM BEING EXPOSED TO HIT BALLS.**
- 11. NO PRIVATE LESSONS OR PERSONAL TRAINING.**
- 12. NO T-BALL OR SOFT TOSS HITTING OUTSIDE OF THE BATTING CAGE.**
- 13. NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED INSIDE THE BATTING CAGE.**
- 14. NO PETS ALLOWED INSIDE THE BATTING CAGE.**
